A local chef and outside events caterer with a background in teaching cookery, Guy is passionate about good food made simply. ## The Music Box

### The place to sit, listen and be entertained

**Fiddlebox** were so popular at last year's events, we just had to ask them back! So, welcome again to Helen (the Fiddle) Adam and George (The Box) Whitfield, described as 'sounding more like a four-piece than a duo'. Helen and George have been together for 13 years, and draw on a massive repertoire with traditional Welsh, Irish, American, Klezmer and rock roots, as well as their own material. Fiddlebox play over 100 gigs a year throughout Wales, England and overseas.



**Tudor Thomas** (trombone and vocals) has led traditional jazz bands in the Midlands, East Anglia, the West Country and West Wales over a 30-year period. Tudor and his Christmas Crackers perform a varied programme of foot-tapping Dixieland jazz with an interesting sprinkling of vocals and are a particular favourite at the Brecon, Fishguard and Llandeilo Jazz festivals. So sit back, relax and enjoy the sounds of this popular classic jazz band.



**Quarto** is a folk band based in Pembrokeshire, who sing and play contemporary and traditional songs and tunes. Their repertoire includes everything from traditional pieces to their own material and from rousing singalongs to delicate ballads. The instruments they play are fiddles, guitars, mandolins and whistles.



**Saundersfoot Community Primary School Choir** will be providing a programme of traditional Christmas Carols to open the market. Children from the school will also be following Santa as he leads the 100s of lights in our **new Lantern Parade** and the switching on of the Sensory Garden Christmas Tree lights and Harbour Decking Illuminations.



**'The Butch Boys'** Three talented musicians who have been providing great impromptu entertainment during the summer. These are our local entertainer 'Butch' (Guitar & vocals) together with two regular visitors to Saundersfoot Richard (Double Bass) and Chris (Harmonica). An enjoyable evening is guaranteed.
